THE PARISH GARDEN, it is with regret that after this season I (John Mclelland) will be retiring from organising the garden, therefore we are looking for more volunteers to help with the garden. At present we have 4 ladies our garden angels who look after the weeding and planting out the memorial garden, at the end of this season we will need someone to lead the garden team, especially men. What's involved? The garden is divided into three main jobs, **1.** Grass cutting, which is managed by Tommy McGuire. **2.** Hedge trimming which is managed by Sandy Quither, for which we are thankful and **3**. Weeding and planting the memorial garden, at present we have 5 people taking care of this job which only takes one hour each month during the summer but with more volunteers we can keep this part of the garden looking good, but we will need someone to lead the team, I will be around to give advice if needed. At the end of May we will be planting out the garden, so if you would like to make a small donation of a couple of pounds to help us purchase the plants, please give your donation to Fr Krzysztof or John Mclelland. **The Garden Angels are meeting in the garden next Wednesday after mass** to prepare the garden for the First Holy Communions. If you are interested in helping please join us and if you would like to lead the group, I will explain to you what is involved, trust me it is not a difficult or hard job.
