



## **HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION**

Thursday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Vigil Mass on Wednesday at 7.00 pm

Morning Mass on Thursday at 10.00 am

The bus will be leaving St Patrick's, Craigneuk, on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August at 5.00am sharp. We will be travelling direct to Oban for the ferry to Mull boarding at 9.25am. The ferry takes roughly 1 hour to Mull. Once there, we will travel on the bus again for around 45 minutes to the ferry port for Iona. This ferry is a "walk-on" so the bus will remain in Mull awaiting our return. The ferry from Mull back to Oban will board at 4.35pm. Once we arrive back in Oban, we will go a hotel to check in. People can do their "own thing" for dinner. Fr Krzysztof will advise on his plans if people want to join him.

Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> we will have breakfast in the hotel. Fr Krzysztof will advise on the time of Mass. After Mass, there will be time to explore and have lunch before getting the bus back to St Patrick's with the time confirmed by the driver in the morning.
