Joseph Toal BY THE GRACE OF GOD AND THE AUTHORITY OF THE APOSTOLIC SEE BISHOP OF MOTHERWELL Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2024 Feast of the Holy Family DECREE JUBILEE 2025 "PILGRIMS OF HOPE"

Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica on the 24<sup>th</sup> December, marking the beginning of the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025. The Jubilee will end on the 6<sup>th</sup> January 2026, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. On this day, Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December, the Feast of the Holy Family, I solemnly opened the Jubilee Year in our Cathedral, following the rite provided by the Holy See, and proclaimed this Decree. In the Bull of Indiction for the Ordinary Jubilee of the Year 2025, *Spes non confundit* [Hope does not disappoint] (9th May 2024), Pope Francis invites us to discover the gift of the Jubilee Indulgence: "The indulgence, in fact, allows us to discover the ultimate nature of God's mercy." The Apostolic Penitentiary specifies the places where the grace of indulgence may be received during the Jubilee Year • Any place linked to the Jubilee in Rome and the Holy Land, • The Cathedral of the Diocese, • Other Places designated by the local Ordinary (Bishop). By this decree, I hereby declare that all the faithful who desire may receive the 'Plenary Indulgence' in the diocese of Motherwell, by going on pilgrimage or by visiting:

- Our Cathedral of Our Lady of Good Aid, Motherwell.
- The National Marian Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes at Carfin.
- Parish Churches within the Diocese of Motherwell during a Parish Mission and/or during 40 Hours Adoration.
