Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonised in Rome on Divine Mercy Sunday. There will be a Mass of thanksgiving for this event in Carfin Grotto on Sunday the 4th May, presided by Bishop Toal. All are welcome.

Carlo Acutis was a British-born Italian teenager known for his devotion to the Eucharist, which became a core theme of his life prior to his death from leukaemia at the age of 15 in 2006. In 2013, a cause for his canonization was opened. He was beatified by Pope Francis on 10th October 2020.
