Thank you to all the Parishioners who are taxpayers and members of the Gift Aid scheme. Your contributions are greatly appreciated and resulted in the Parish receiving £6116 from HMRC for payments in the last tax year (2025)

We are now making a special appeal to Parishioners, who pay tax but are not currently members of the Gift Aid Scheme, to consider signing up. There is no cost to you as a tax payer, you do not need to commit to paying a fixed amount per year, the claim that will be submitted will be based on the amount paid in by envelopes or by sums made straight to the Church bank account. Our membership fell by 27 last year which means we will receive considerably less tax rebate from HMRC compared to the previous claim. Forms to sign up for this scheme are on the table at the back of the church, please complete one, it only takes a minute, and then return it to Margaret McKeown or to Fr Ricky, we will then forward them to the Diocese for processing. New envelopes for this year are ready for collection at the back of the Church.
